1) Waiver:

To participate in the Epic Relays OR Relay to be held on June 17-18, 2011, I accept all rules and regulations and will comply with them. I assume all risks and waive claim for injury. I am physically fit and sufficiently trained to participate in this event. In consideration of your acceptance of this entry, I, the undersigned, intending to be legally bound for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, waive and release all rights and claims for damages I may have against the OR relay, Epic Relays, 7 Summits Sports, Inc., race directors, volunteers, state of OR and all other race sponsors, spectators and anyone connected with the race. I grant my immutable permission to the race organization to use my name, relay photographs, Relay video recordings or record of my participation in this event for any purpose. I understand that my entry fee is non-refundable and the race will be held regardless of weather conditions.

2) Rules:

All of the following rules apply to any team that wishes to participate in an Epic Relays event and especially any team or individual that desires to qualify as a winner in any of the relay classifications.

1. Present the following at Relay Start Check In:
 - 2 first aid kits (1 for each vehicle)
 - Glass Chalk to write "CAUTION RUNNER ON ROAD" on the back of the team vehicles
 - At least 2 reflective vests
 - At least 2 headlamps

- At least 2 red blinking LED lights
 - Extra batteries
 - **2011 Epic Oregon Relay – Relay Participant Waiver** signed by all runners, drivers, pacers and volunteers
 - **2011 Epic Oregon Relay – Runner Order Form**
 - 2 Relayology Manuals (1 for each vehicle)
2. Between the hours of 8pm and 6am (unless told otherwise by a volunteer) runners must wear a reflective vest, headlamp or flashlight and red blinking LED light
 3. Pacers may only run with runners between the hours of 8pm and 6am and must follow ALL relay rules (especially night rules)
 4. Teams must keep to the Runner Order Form unless someone gets injured or they choose the non competitive category. In the event of an injury or illness a member from that team may step in and run the injured teammate's legs. Pacers, drivers or volunteers may not step in to run the injured teammate's legs.
 5. Teams must fill out the **2011 Epic Oregon Relay – Team Time Record** and submit it at the Relay Finish to be eligible to win
 6. Teams must choose one of the two volunteer options
 7. Teams must run/walk the entire relay course
 8. Teams must AVERAGE at least a 10:30/mile pace
 9. Team vehicles must seat at least 6 seat belted passengers but no more than 15 and be less than 20' long
 10. RV's or motor homes are not permitted on the course
 11. Team vehicles may not pace runners
 12. Runners, drivers and pacers must obey all traffic laws
 13. Runners must always wear their team race number while running
 14. Bicycles are not permitted on the course
 15. Pets are not permitted to participate with runners on the course
 16. Participants must be at least 14 years old on the day of the relay
 17. Participants under the age of 18 must have a parent/guardian sign the Relay Participant Waiver
 18. Any changes to your team after May 25, 2011 will result in a \$15 processing fee per change and a **2011 Epic Oregon Relay – Runner/Volunteer Substitution Form** must be completed for EACH runner/volunteer substitution and handed in at the Relay Start Check In.
 19. Volunteer options **cannot** be changed after May 25, 2011. If a team chooses volunteer option 1 and then decides to opt for option 2 the fee of \$195 must be received by us in the mail along with a written notice signed by the team captain stating the change by May 25, 2011 (make checks out to 7 Summits Sports). If a team chooses volunteer option 2 and then decides to opt for option 1 a letter or email stating this must be received by us by May 25, 2011 in order for the team to receive a \$195 refund.

I have read all rules regarding the 2011 Epic Oregon Relay and understand and accept all that is expected of myself and my team as participants in this event.

3) Payment:

Epic Exclusive Registration (July 7, 2010 - July 31, 2010):

Only available to 2010 Epic Oregon Relay participants

\$708 for 12 member teams and \$354 for ultra teams (\$59 per runner)

With a \$100 deposit you secure the Epic Exclusive Registration price and your team's spot in the Epic Oregon

Full payment is not due until November 1, 2010

Epic Early Registration (July 7, 2010 - August 31, 2010):

\$828 for 12 member teams and \$414 for ultra teams (\$69 per runner)

With a \$100 deposit you secure the Epic Early Registration price and your team's spot in the Epic Oregon

Full payment is not due until December 1, 2010

Early Registration (September 1, 2010 - November 30, 2010):

\$948 for 12 member teams and \$474 for ultra teams (\$79 per runner)

With a \$100 deposit you secure the Early Registration price and your team's spot in the Epic Oregon

Full payment is not due until March 1, 2011

Regular Registration (December 1, 2010 - February 28, 2011):

\$1068 for 12 member teams and \$534 for ultra teams (\$89 per runner)

With a \$100 deposit you secure the Regular Registration price and your team's spot in the Epic Oregon

Full payment is not due until April 15, 2011

Late Registration (March 1 - April 30):

\$1188 for 12 member teams and \$594 for ultra teams (\$99 per runner).

Last Second Registration (May 1 - May 25):

\$1308 for 12 member teams and \$654 for ultra teams (\$109 per runner).

***Any changes to your team** after registration closes on May 25, 2011 will result in a \$15 processing fee per change and a Runner/Volunteer Substitution Form must be completed for EACH runner/volunteer substitution and handed in at the Relay Start Check In.

***Return Policy:** Payments are non refundable and non transferable, however a team captain may be replaced. The replacement captain will still be responsible for finding a team and taking over all responsibilities of the prior team captain under the existing team name.
